can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

If you experience any of the following side effects you should tell your doctor immediately.

-Generalised allergic reactions including swelling beneath the skin that can occur in areas such as the face and limbs, and can obstruct the airway which may cause difficulty swallowing or breathing, hives or itchy rash, localised and generalised rash, itchiness, severe sudden life-threatening allergic reaction.

 Serious illness with severe peeling and swelling of the skin, blistering of the skin, mouth, eyes, genitals and fever.

Skin rash with pink-red blotches especially on palms of hands or soles of feet which may blister.

Other possible side effects include:

 Burning and stinging of the eyes, unusual taste.

Redness in and around the eye(s), watering or itching of the eye(s), and effects on the surface of the eye(s), swelling and/or irritation in and around the eye(s), feeling of having something in the eye (corneal erosion), decreased corneal sensitivity (not realising of getting something in the eye and not feeling pain), eye pain, dry eyes, blurred vision, headache, sinusitis (feeling of tension or fullness in the nose), feeling sick, also called nausea, and fatique.

-Dizziness, depression, inflammation of the iris, blurred vision (in some cases due to withdrawal of medication to treat excessive contraction of the pupil of the eye), slow heartbeat, fainting, laboured breathing, indigestion, and kidney stones (often marked by a sudden onset of excruciating, cramping pain in their low back and/or side, groin, or abdomen).

If any of the side effects get serious, or if you notice any side effects not listed in this leaflet, please tell your doctor or pharmacist.

original container away from direct light. Store below 30°C. •Keep this medicine in a safe place where children cannot see or reach

•Throw away the bottle after 4 weeks of first opening.

1.What DORZIM-I Drops are and what they are used for

Category: Anti glaucoma

DDRZIM-IDrops are a combination of two medicines: Dorzolamide and Timolol. Dorzolamide belongs to a group of medicines called carbonic anhydrase inhibitors. Timolol belongs to a group of medicines called beta blockers. DDRZIM-I Drops are prescribed to lower raised pressure within the eye in the treatment of glaucoma when beta blocker eve drops used alone are not adequate.

2.What you need to know before vou use DORZIM-I Drops Caution

Do not use DORZIM-I if you are: Allergic to Dorzolamide or Timolol. beta blockers or any of the other ingredients of this medicine.

Do not use in your eyes if you:

·Have now or have had in the past respiratory problems such as asthma, severe chronic obstructive lung disease (severe lung disease which may cause wheeziness. difficulty in breathing and/or long-standing cough).

·Have severe kidney problems, or a prior history of kidney stones.

·Have a disturbance in the pH (acid/alkali balance) of your blood. ·Have certain heart problems. including certain heart rhythm disturbances producing an abnormally slow heart rate or severe heart failure.

 Coronary heart disease (symptoms can include chest pain or tightness, breathlessness or choking), Prinzmental's angina (chest pain while resting), heart failure, low blood pressure.

·Poor blood circulation disease (such as Raynaud's disease or Ravnaud's syndrome).

•Diabetes as DORZIM-I Drops may mask signs and symptoms of low blood sugar.

 Overactivity of the thyroid gland as DORZIM-I Drops may mask signs

·Liver problems, if you have muscle weakness or have been diagnosed as having myasthenia gravis.

Take special care with DDRZIM-I Drops:

·If you develop conjunctivitis (redness and irritation of the eves). swelling of the eye or eyelids, skin rash or itching in and around the eve contact your doctor immediately. ·You should be aware that if you are using DDRZIM-I Drops in your eyes your doctor may need to check your eyes frequently during your treatment.

•Tell your doctor if you develop an eve infection, receive an eve injury. have eye surgery, develop other reactions or worsening of symptoms.

Other medicines and DORZIM-I

•Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking, have recently taken or might take any other medicines. ·Before surgery and anaesthesia

(even at the dentist), tell your doctor or dentist that you are using DORZIM-I Drops, as this medicine may change effects of some medicines used during anaesthesia and there may be a sudden fall in blood pressure associated with the anaesthetic.

·You are taking antihypertensive medicines which are used to lower high blood pressure or medicines to treat heart disease such as calcium channel blockers and beta blockers or digoxin.

·You are taking medicines to treat a disturbed or uneven heartbeat such as quinidine or digoxin.

You are using other eve drops that contains a beta blocker.

·You are taking another carbonic anhydrase inhibitor such as acetazolamide. You may be taking this type of medicine by mouth, as eve drops, or by some other method.

·You are taking quinidine (used to treat heart conditions and some types of malaria) You are taking monoamine oxidase inhibitors (MAOIs) or selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors (SSRIs) (such as fluoxetine and paroxetine) both of which are used to treat depression or another illness.

 You are taking a parasympathomimetic medicine which may have been prescribed to help you pass urine. Parasympathomimetics are also a particular type of medicine which are sometimes used to help restore normal movements through the bowel.

·You are taking narcotics such as morphine used to treat moderate to severe pain or if you are taking large doses of aspirin. Although there is no evidence that dorzolamide hydrochloride interacts with aspirin, some other medicines which are related to dorzolamide hydrochloride and which are taken by mouth, have been known to interact with aspirin

·You are taking medicines to treat diabetes or high blood sugar.

·You are taking epinephrine (adrenaline).

If you are using other eye drops or eve ointments. leave at least 5 minutes between each medicine.

Eye ointments should be administered last.

•DORZIM-I Drops contain Benzalkonium chloride: Benzalkonium chloride may cause eve irritation and is known to discolour soft contact lenses. therefore contact with such lenses should be avoided. If you wear contact lens you should remove it prior to application and wait at least 15 minutes before putting your lenses back in.

Driving and using machines:

DORZIM-I Drops can cause temporary blurring of vision after application to the eye. Wait until your vision is clear whilst driving or using machines.

Pregnancy, breast-feeding & fertility:

If you are pregnant, think you may be pregnant or are planning to have a baby, ask your doctor or pharmacist advice before using this medicine

•You should not use p□RZIM-I Drops if you are breastfeeding.

3.How to use DORZIM-I Drops Always use this medicine exactly as described in this leaflet or as your doctor or pharmacist has told you. Check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure.

How much to use for adults, the elderly and children

The appropriate dosage and duration of treatment will be established by your doctor. The recommended dose is one drop in the affected eye(s) two times a

Instructions for use

If you wear soft contact lenses these must be removed during treatment of the eves with DDRZIM-I Drops.

1. Before opening a new bottle of Drops, please check that the safety strip on the bottom of the outer cap is unbroken.

2. Twist the outer cap to break the

3.Wash your hands well before

4. Remove the outer cap. If you are putting in the drops vourself you should use a mirror. 5. Tilt your head back and look up

at the ceiling. 6.Pull the lower lid of the eve out to form a small pocket between your evelid and your eve.

7. Hold the container between the thumb and middle finger of the other hand, turn the bottle upside down near to your eve. try not to touch your eve with the nozzle.

8.Apply enough pressure to the container to release one to two drops, or as directed by your doctor. 9.Blink your eye a few times.

10.If you think that you have missed your eve. then insert another drop.

11.Repeat steps 5 -10 in the other eve,if you have been told to use DORZIM-I Drops in both eyes.

12. Replace the outer cap on the bottle, trying not to touch the applicator tip with anything. including the eye or your fingers. 13. Wash your hands.

If you use more DORZIM-I Drops than you should:

If you are at all concerned that you have used too much of this medicine contact your doctor or pharmacist.

DDRZIM-I Drops are for external

If you forget to use DORZIM-I Drops:

Use a single drop as soon as you remember and then go back to your regular dosing routine. However, if it is almost time for your next dose, skip the missed dose before going back to your regular dosing routine. Do not use a double dose to make up for the one missed.

If you stop using DORZIM-I Drops:

You should keep using DORZIM-I Drops for as long as your doctor has instructed. Your treatment is helping your condition, even if you have not noticed a difference in how you feel. Should you need to stop your treatment, your doctor will advise you how to do this.
